Conclusion



The session proved to be highly informative, equipping students with essential financial knowledge and encouraging active participation in RBI initiatives.


Proceedings of the session:



Conclusion







Objective :-


The objective of this visit was to provide school students with an opportunity to explore our college campus, library and computer lab and gain hand-on experience with various resources and technologies.

8. Lecture on the topic “ How to prepare for Competitive Exam UGC-NET” organised by CCPC on 22.04.2025














