

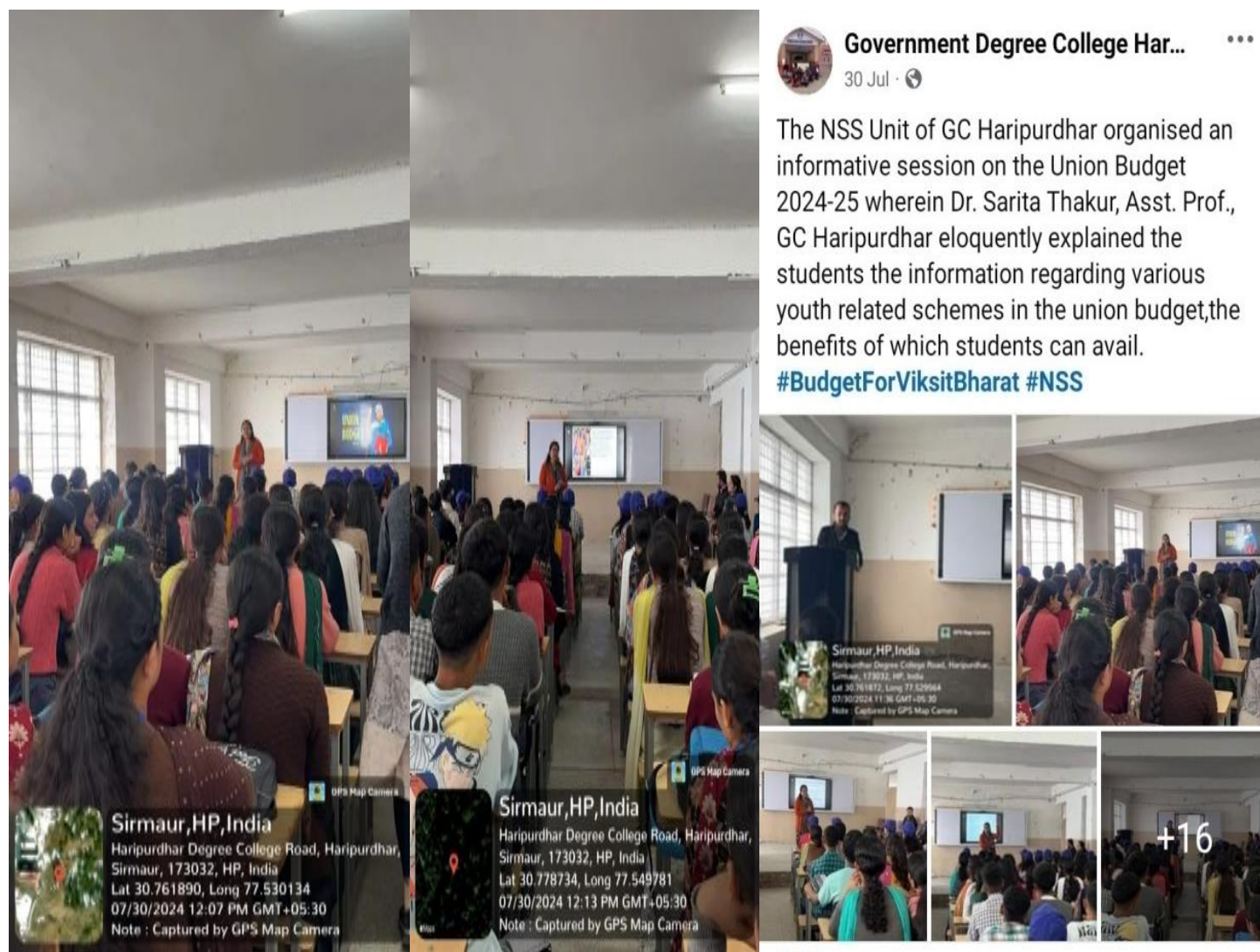

Objectives: CAMPUS BEAUTIFICATION AND FEMALE HYGIENE EDUCATION.

INTRODUCTION: The NSS unit of the institution organised a one-day camp for the students focusing on the installation of fence posts and a sturdy gate to secure the college campus. A lecture was also organised for female students and staff for education on hygiene.

Volunteers gathered stones from around the college campus and worked to dig holes and set fence posts around the entry area college campus.

Fencing gates were installed and tightened to ensure a strong barrier.

A makeshift gate with locking system was also made by the students to be installed at the entry point.

Beautification of the campus was conducted where students cleaned the campus and gathered waste from around the college campus.

To guide the NSS volunteers from GSSS Korag about the values and essence of NSS.


To provide counselling about career options available to students after senior secondary education.

Conclusion

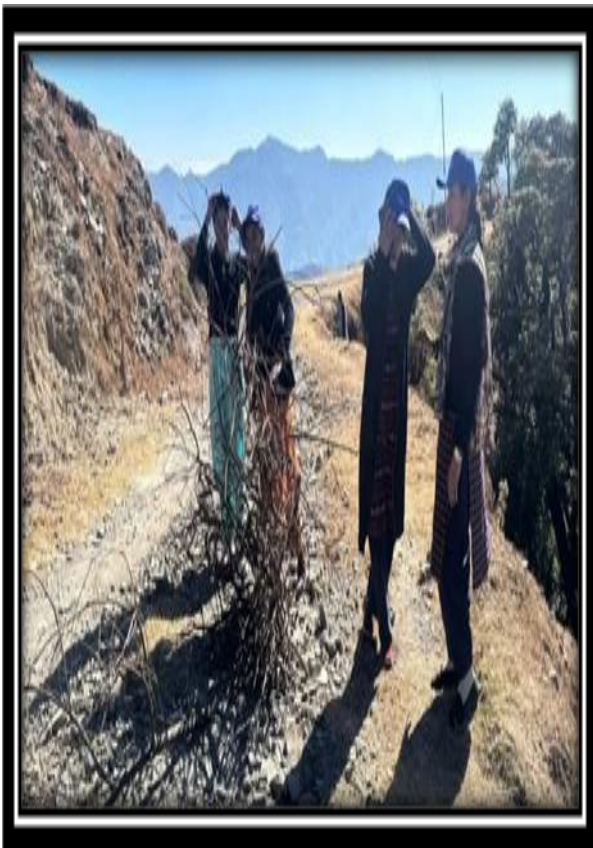

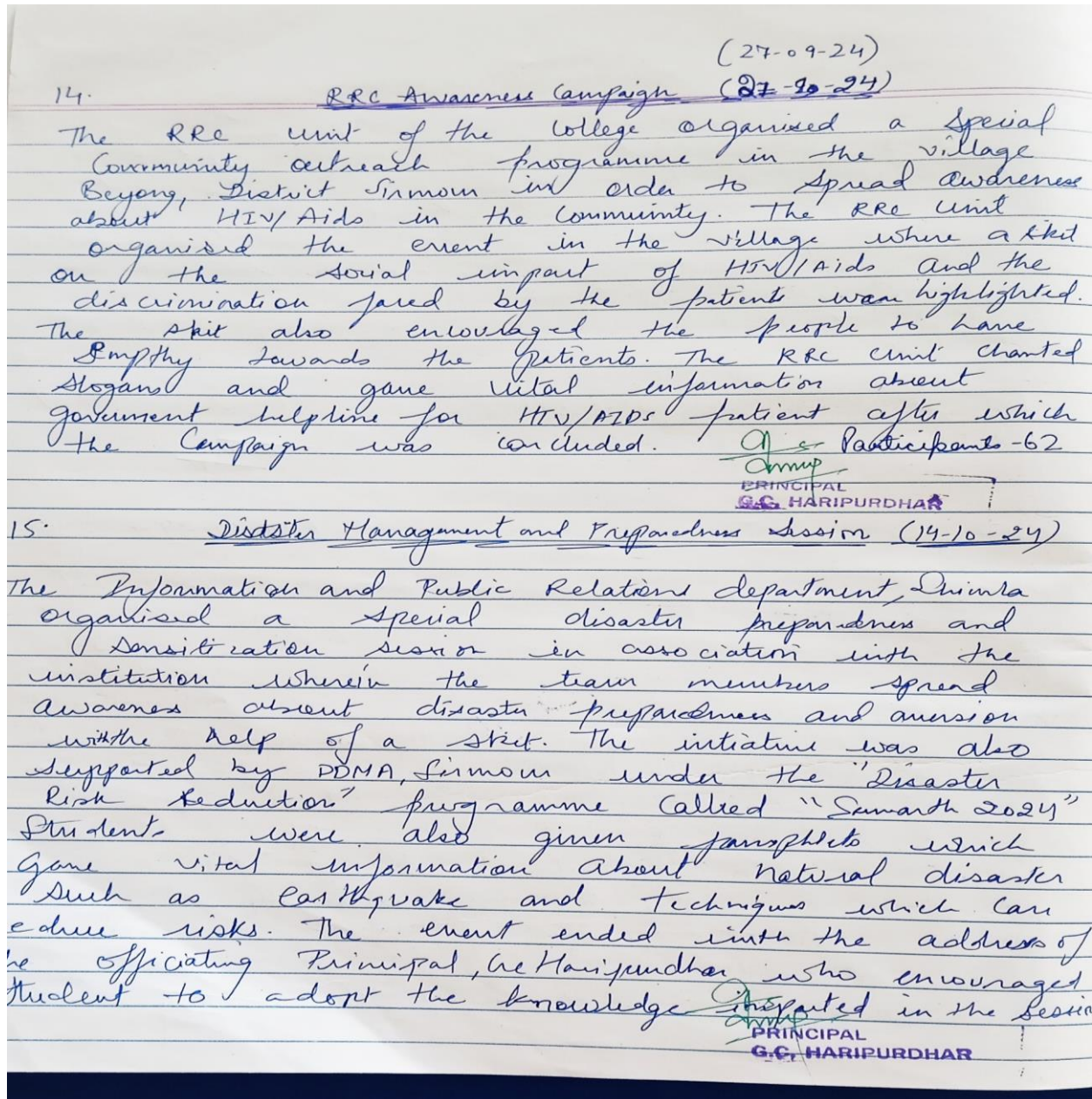


2. Scout and Guide Scarf Day (01-08-24)
