


2. NSS One-Day Swacchta Camp:- One Day Swacchta Camp was organised by NSS Unit on 31.08.2024






To guide the NSS volunteers from GSSS Korag about the values and essence of NSS.


To provide counselling about career options available to students after senior secondary education.




iv. STUDENTS PARTICIPATING IN ROAD SAFETY CLUBS (2024-2025)




