


Special Initiative 1: "Donor's Nook": Book Donation and Reading Guidance

The college has started an initiative called Donor's Nook to encourage reading and knowledge sharing. In this practice, teachers and non-teaching staff donate books to the college library. A separate almirah has been kept for these books, and each book has been numbered. An issue register is maintained to record when books are borrowed and returned.

To make the activity more meaningful, staff members also hold short sessions with students. In these sessions, they talk about one book they donated, explain why it is important and encourage students to read it.

This initiative helps in increasing the number of books in the library and also gives students guidance on useful reading material. It also builds a closer connection between staff and students through the habit of reading.





ACTIVITY REPORT: OVERVIEW OF DONATED BOOK BY SH. KARAM DUTT



Introduction: Under the "Donor's Nook" initiative of the college, in which faculty members of the institution donate books to the college library and give a brief overview of one book donated by them, Sh. Karam Dutt (AP Sociology) gave a summary lecture of one book donated by him i.e. *CSAT PAPER 2 PREPARATION* on 23-04-25.

Objectives:

1. To help students qualify the prelims by scoring at least 33% (66 marks out of 200).
2. To build logical reasoning, comprehension, and decision-making skills.

Proceedings:

Sh. Karam Dutt, in his overview, emphasised that the book is designed to help aspirants understand the fundamental concepts required for CSAT Paper 2. He highlighted the book's focus on developing analytical and logical skills through content and practice sets. According to him, the book helps aspirants build confidence in candidates by providing a step-by-step approach to problem-solving.

Conclusion: The students were satisfied with the lecture and wanted to explore the different aspects of examinations like UPSC. The session developed curiosity to read the full book and understand ways to enhance their problem solving skills.




Objectives:

2. To support first-semester students in learning important topics like force, motion, and mechanics.



3. To understand the importance of grooming in personal growth.




Special Initiative 3: Resource Generation through Community and Stakeholder Support
