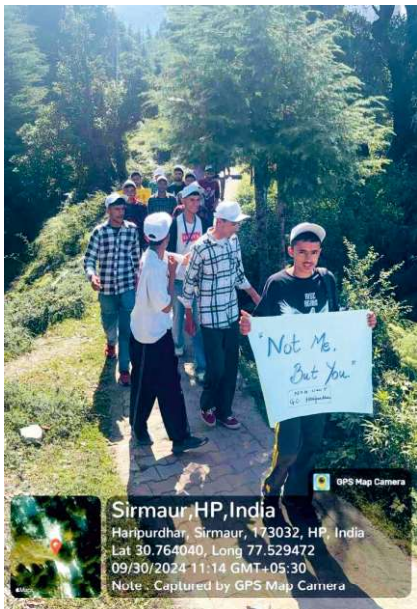

COLLEGE CHRONICLE 2024-25



On July 27, 2024, The NSS Unit of the college organised a session on the Union Budget 2024-25 wherein Dr. Sarita Thakur, Asst. Professor (Commerce), GC Haripurdhar eloquently gave the students the information regarding various youth related schemes in the union budget, the benefits of which students can avail.

On August 01, 2024, the Rovers and Rangers unit of the college celebrated Scout Scarf Day. A scarf ceremony was organised, followed by a special session highlighting the rich heritage and history of the scout movement.

On August 05, 2024, A special orientation programme was organised in the institution for the Students of first year wherein students were amply guided regarding the academic and non academic activities conducted in the college. A familiarisation session was also conducted in order to facilitate the newly admitted students.

On August 13, 2024, an orientation programme was organised for the NSS Volunteers of the institution which highlighted the values and aims of National Service Scheme.

On August 15, 2024, the 78th Independence Day was observed in the institution wherein the NCC, NSS and Rovers and rangers units conducted a flag march and a flag hoisting ceremony, along with various cultural activities.

On August 29, 2024, National Sports Day was observed in the college. The event aimed to encourage virtues of sportsmanship and discipline among the students.

On August 31, 2024, Career Counseling and Placement Cell, GC Haripurdhar organised a lecture on "Women Hygiene" under Mahila Suraksha Mission in association with Tiens India International Health Industry. The speaker of this lecture was Smt. Geeta Singh.

On August 31, 2024, The NSS unit of GC Haripurdhar organised a one day camp wherein a campus beautification drive was conducted in the campus.

On September 05, 2024, Teachers' day was celebrated in the college. The students organised various cultural and entertainment activities to express their gratitude towards their teachers.

On September 10, 2024, the Library Inspection Committee visited the college in which it evaluated the functioning of the library for the purpose of ranking as per the directions of Worthy Director of Higher Education, Himachal Pradesh.

On September 14, 2024 on the occasion of Hindi Diwas, a *Hindi Pakhwara* was organised in Gaiety Theatre, Shimla. Four students of the college participated in Declamation contest, Quiz, Essay Writing and Poetry Writing. Pradeep Thakur of BAI secured 2nd position in the state-level Hindi Quiz competition. On the same day, various competitions like declamation, poetry, essay writing, etc., were also organised in the college.

On September 16, 2024, a guest lecture "Banking and Financial Inclusion" was conducted in association with Sh. Ram Lal, the representative of the Reserve Bank of India. Vital information on the functioning of RBI was given and the students were encouraged to participate in the National-Level RBI Quiz.

From September 17, 2024 to October 02, 2024, the *Swacchta hi Seva* Campaign was observed in the college in which a score of activities were organised by the NSS Unit of the College including Documentary show, a market rally, Campus Beautification and cleanliness drives across Maa Bhangayani Temple, Haripurdhar Market and adopted village Beyong.

On September 19, 2024, the CSCA for the academic session 2024-25 was constituted as per the norms of Himachal Pradesh University, Shimla.

In addition to this, an HIV/AIDS health awareness programme was organised in which the key speaker was Dr. Atul Bhardwaj, Block Medical Officer, Sangrah Block.

On September 28, 2024, a Mock Drill was organised in the college in association with the 4th Battalion of Home Guards and Fire Department, Nahan, wherein quick response action training was given to the students to manage rescue operations in emergency situations and disasters.

On October 01, 2024, an AIDS awareness skit was organised in the Adopted village, Beyong by the members of the Red Ribbon Club.

On October 05, 2024, a friendly Kabaddi Match was organised by the Sports Committee for the boys of the institution to enhance their physical fitness and train them for future tournaments.

On October 07, 2024, a community outreach programme was organised by the NSS and CCPC Unit at GSSS, Korag.

On October 10, 2024, a District Level Red Run Marathon was organised at Chaugan Ground, Nahan by the Department of Health and Family Welfare, district Sirmour. Four students from the college participated in the marathon.

On October 14, 2024, the college, in collaboration with the Information and Public Relations Department, Shimla, organised a special disaster preparedness and sensitisation session in which the team members raised awareness about disaster preparedness and aversion with the help of a skit.

From October 22 to October 25, 2024, a state-level Nipun testing camp was held in Rewalsar, district Mandi. Eight Rangers from the college, along with the Rangers Leader, Prof. Versha Rani participated in the camp.

On October 21, 2024, a Freshers' Programme was organised by the students of BA II and BA III to welcome the newly admitted students.

On November 18, 2024, the SAR cluster committee visited the college for the purpose of ranking as per the directions of the worthy Director of Higher Education, Himachal Pradesh.

On November 07, 2024, the 24th Bharat Scouts and Guides Foundation Day was observed in the college.

On November 11, 2024, the CCPC organised a faculty visit to two of the adopted schools, GSSS Haripurdhar and GCPS, Haripurdhar wherein two faculty members, Ms. Himadri Thakur and Dr. Sarita Thakur conducted lectures for the students of these schools.

On November 16, 2024 and November 26, 2024, the Electoral Literacy Club conducted two Voter Registration camps to educate students on the significance of voting and participation in elections. The students of the institution who had not been registered for voting were also registered.

On November 16, 2024, a one day camp was organised by the NSS unit of the college wherein the NSS volunteers organised a drive to maintain the flower beddings across the college. A boundary wall was also built around the beddings using leftover stones.

Professor at Shoolini University, Solan who underscored the importance of time management and goal setting. She also gave vital information about different types of State and Central government exams that students can appear for.

On December 12, a session was organised by the NSS unit for the volunteers for the registration of volunteers for the MyBharat Quiz on the occasion of Human Rights Day.

From February 22, 2025 to February 28, 2025, a Workshop titled “*Nati Nritya & Geet: A Cultural Skill Workshop*” was conducted in the college by the Cultural Committee in Association with the OSA Formation and Management Committee in which the key trainer, Sh. Randeep, a local artist, who is also an alumnus of the college, trained the students regarding local traditional folk songs and dances.





On February 24, 2025, the NSS unit of GDC Haripurdhar, in collaboration with the Eco Club, Parent-Teacher Association (PTA), and CSCA, organised a plantation drive aimed at promoting environmental conservation. This initiative focused on increasing the green cover within the campus and fostering awareness regarding the significance of afforestation.

On March 19, 2025, a farewell programme for the students of B.A III was organised by the students of B.A. I and B.A. II.

On March 20, 2025, a guest lecture titled "Health Hazards due to Drug Abuse" was organised by the Anti-Drug Committee in collaboration with the CCPC of the college. The keynote speaker was Sh. Chaman Soni, Health Educator, CHC Sangrah, Distt. Sirmour (H.P.) who educated the students on dangers of drug abuse, drug detection methods, law enforcement actions, and prevention strategies.

On March 20, 2025, an Oath Taking Ceremony of the Road Safety Club was held in the college, in which the students resolved to follow traffic rules.

On March 20, 2025, the Red Ribbon Club of the college organised a walkathon to raise awareness about HIV/AIDS. The aim was educate and inspire the community about this crucial health issue.

On March 23, 2025, as a part of the community outreach programme, a Mental Health Awareness Session through Indic Practices was organised for the local community of Haripurdhar at the HPPWD Rest House, in which students from the college and people from the local community took part.

On March 24, 2025, a programme was organised by the Women Development Cell in association with the Directorate of Women and Child Development, wherein the guest speakers, Ms. Kritika Thakur and Ms. Yuvika Chauhan, explained the students about menstrual hygiene and women empowerment. On the same day, an online lecture on "Medicinal Herbs and Plants" was organised by the Eco Club of the institution in which the guest speaker, Dr. Tara Sen Thakur educated the students on the health and financial benefits of various plants.

On March 26, 2025 and March 27, 2025 the Anti-Drug Committee organised counseling sessions for students to assess their proneness to addiction and counsel them regarding the hazards of drug addiction.
